

Longmont Buddhist Temple | 2023 Memberships

Dear Members and Friends:

Longmont Buddhist Temple sincerely thanks you for your support. We are grateful for your generous giving despite these challenging times. We ask that you continue this generosity as we enter our 98th year and we encourage you to purchase a membership in 2023.

Your memberships and donations support Longmont Buddhist Temple's religious and educational programs. You support the temple's critical operations, including the minister's salary, utilities, maintenance, and Buddhist Churches of America membership dues, currently set at \$166.90 per person. Since the pandemic began, your contributions have allowed us to make important technological improvements to virtually provide the Dharma message and other activities of interconnection.

Our 2023 operating budget sets our membership goal at \$30,000. In normal years, memberships and donations provide the majority revenue needed to meet our annual operating expenses. With our current number of members, each person would need to donate over \$1000 for us to even come close to our budget. Not all are able to contribute at this level, so we have created a tiered system. Those who are able to donate more are encouraged to do so. The 2023 member levels are as follows:

- Contributing Membership, \$400 per person
- Supporting Membership, \$650 per person
- Sustaining Membership, \$1000+

There is no minimum requirement for temple donations. We have a LBT Friend option which allows you to give what you can financially. We appreciate every donation including time and effort through volunteerism and engagement.
